## Eligibility and Guidelines

- Open to students pursuing B.E./B.Tech with either a Smart India Hackathon (SIH) project or a college project that includes a working prototype.
- Inter-college team members are not allowed.
- Inter-specialization team members are allowed.
- Project problem statements must be clear, innovative, and well-defined.
- Teams must adhere to the presentation time limit and maintain professional conduct throughout the event.

## Rules & Structure

### Round 1 – Online Submission

- Teams must register on Unstop.com and submit a prepared pitch deck in PDF or PPT format.
- The pitch deck should include:
  1. Problem Statement
  2. Proposed Solution
  3. Implementation Approach
- No registration fee is required for this round.
- Shortlisting will be based on innovation, feasibility, and presentation quality.

**Round 2 – On-Campus Finale** • Shortlisted teams will be invited to present their projects live at MNIT Jaipur.

- A panel of judges consisting of industry experts and entrepreneurs will assess presentations.
- Each team will get 8–10 minutes including Q&A.

The index reflects the combined reach, engagement depth, and mentorship interaction created through the event.
